The Board of Directors for NASBA will be holding a meeting July 21-22, 2016 in Rapid City, SD.

Recap from ED Conference

- Legal Cases Updates – an update on the fallout from the NC dental case and how various states are implementing changes; changes from the IRS losing the case to regulate tax preparers; how to handle civil settlement notification; briefings on various cases from across the USA with boards of accountancy (Nevada, Oregon, Massachusetts, Tennessee); the impact of medical and recreational marijuana legalization in various states.
- Diversity and Building the Profession – information and suggestions on how to bring diversity to the boards.
- Legislative Strategies – and update on various legislation being introduced or how it has progressed throughout the states and bills to be aware of.
- Uniform CPA Exam update – update on the practice analysis and the new CPA exam to be introduced in April 2017.
- Peer Review – Enhancing peer reviewer quality; improving engagement and firm tracking; increasing transparency; strengthening enforcement; evolving peer review administration.
- Leveraging data for more effective enforcement – asking boards to collect EIN numbers for firms for cross-reference; how to get started and the checklist being provided by NASBA and the ALD committee.
- Leadership Training – Engaging your Board – what board members expect from the organization; what board members do for the organization; perspectives from an Executive Director and a Board member.
- Education and Accreditation – update on changes from foreign education and how to focus what review providers are evaluating.
- State Board Relations update – an overview of the newly designed Executive Director's website and material available.
- CPE Standards Exposure Draft update – nano learning; blended learning; changes to how CPE hours are provided (group and blended starts at 1 then in increments of one-fifth or one-half; self study starts at .5 then in increments of one-fifth or one-half; nano learning as one fifth only)
- AICPA CGMA (Chartered Global Management Accountants) Initiative – the initiative for the CGMA to be offered to non-CPAs and the course of how the AICPA plans to attract new members. Also discussed was the merger of the AICPA with CIMA (Chartered Institute of Management Accountants).
